Chapter 105 General Permit Fees
EFFECTIVE February 01, 2017

1. Per PADEP directive, as of February 16, 2013, the following permit fees apply:

GP-1 Fish Habitat Enhancement Structures	\$50.00
GP-2 Small Docks and Boat Launching Ramps	\$175.00
GP-3 Bank Rehab., Bank Protection, Gravel Bar Removal	\$250.00
GP-4 Intake and Outfall Structures	\$200.00
GP-5 Utility Line Stream Crossing	\$250.00
GP-6 Agricultural Crossings and Ramps	\$50.00
GP-7 Minor Road Crossing	\$350.00
GP-8 Temporary Road Crossing	\$175.00
GP-9 Agricultural Activities	\$50.00

Transfer of Water Obstruction & Encroachment Permit:	
With Submerged Lands License Agreement	\$200.00
Without Submerged Lands License Agreement	\$100.00

Make checks payable to the “Indiana County Conservation District – Clean Water Fund”.

2. Projects that are limited to earth disturbance for the General Permit activity only, are not required to pay additional Erosion and Sedimentation Control Plan review fees.
3. Indiana County Conservation District requires that you submit (2) complete copies of the General Permit Registration and (2) copies of the associated Erosion & Sediment Control Plan.
4. Indiana County Conservation District requires that you provide the Aquatic Resource Impact Table, Form 3150-PM-BWEW0557 in electronic format. It may be emailed to info@iccdpa.org at the time of paper submission.
5. Requests for expedited review (within seven working days), *remit an additional check for \$150 per structure, resource crossing or impact*. Make check payable to the “Indiana County Conservation District”. Additional fee must be included with plan submission.

Additional Notes

1. Agencies of the federal government and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania are exempt from all aforementioned fees.
2. Indiana County and its municipalities are exempt from Chapter 105 General Permit fees.
3. A PNDI (PA Natural Diversity Inventory) Receipt is required for the General Permit application. You may obtain a PNDI receipt at <https://conservationexplorer.dcnr.pa.gov/> If you need assistance obtaining a receipt, please contact the Indiana County Conservation District.
4. The expedited review fee applies to applications submitted after the fact as a result of a complaint or discovery of an unpermitted activity.
5. There is a \$75.00 returned check fee.
